

Interoperability Info Sheet - Members

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) established the Interoperability and Patient Access rule (CMS9115-f)(85 FR 25510) to support the 21st Century Cures Act and executive Order in 2019 as a means to “to improve the quality and accessibility of information that Americans need to make informed health care decisions, including data about health care prices and outcomes, while minimizing reporting burdens on affected health care providers and payers.” (<https://www.cms.gov/files/document/cms-9115-f.pdf>)

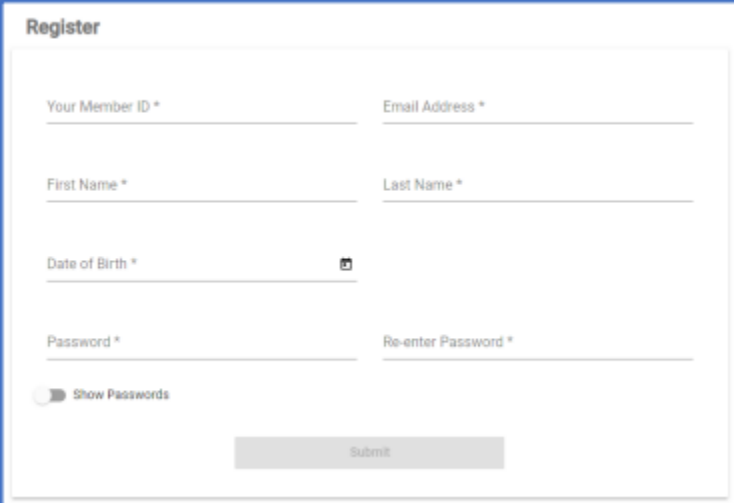
In support of that act, Abilis Health Plan is working along with its respective vendors to provide you, the member, with greater access to your health insurance data. As a part of the first phase of this initiative, Abilis Health Plan and its vendors are providing members with the ability to connect to their health insurance data using standardized Patient Access APIs.

To connect to your health plan information, you will need to select a compatible third-party solution that has registered with Abilis Health Plan. Please follow this link for a listing of applications that are using Patient Access APIs to provide patient data: [My Health Application](#).

As a user, you can allow third party applications access to your health information otherwise typically accessible only through your insurance company. You must register through the Member Access Portal and create a user account before connecting to your account.
